

FIAS Doping Panel Decision – Arman OSPANOV-KAZ

On 15th November 2015 in the occasion of the World SAMBO Championship 2015 in Casablanca, Morocco, was tested positive the athlete Arman OSPANOV to the following substances:

- **Boldenone and its metabolite (5b-androst-1-en-17b-ol-3-one)** is the prohibited substance classified under class S1.1A – Anabolic Androgenic Steroids of the WADA's Prohibited List 2015 and is prohibited in- and out- of competition.
- **1-androstendione and its metabolite (3a-hdroxy-5a-androst-1-en-17-one)** is the prohibited substance classified under class S1.1A – Anabolic Androgenic Steroids of the WADA's Prohibited List 2015 and is prohibited in- and out- of competition.
- **Drostanolone and its metabolite (2a-methyl-5a-androstan-3a-ol-17-one)** is the prohibited substance classified under class S1.1A – Anabolic Androgenic Steroids of the WADA's Prohibited List 2015 and is prohibited in- and out- of competition.
- **Clenbuterol** is the prohibited substance classified under class S1.2- Other Anabolic Agents of WADA's Prohibited List 2015 and is prohibited in- and out- of competition.

FIAS Doping Hearing Panel decided according the article 10.2 of FIAS Anti-Doping Rules 2015 to impose on the athlete a period of four (4) years' ineligibility, starting on 2nd December 2015 and ending at the conclusion of the 2nd December 2019 for his first Anti-Doping rule violation. The results of the athlete, obtained during the World SAMBO Championship 2015 that took place in Casablanca, Morocco, are to be annulled, including forfeiture of medals, points and prizes.
