## REGULATIONS

**2021 SUA Asian SAMBO Championships  
for Sports SAMBO Adults (M-F)  
and Combat SAMBO for Adults (M)  
and Asian Youth and Juniors Championship (M-F)  
at Tashkent, Uzbekistan from 1<sup>st</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> June 2021**

### 1. General terms.

1.1 The 2021 Asian SAMBO Championship among Adults and Asian Combat SAMBO Championship among Adults and the 2021 Asian Youth and Juniors Championship is to be carried out in accordance with the prevalent Competition Rules and Regulations of the International SAMBO Federation [FIAS]

1.2 The 2021 Asian SAMBO Championship among Adults and Asian Combat SAMBO Championship among Adults and the 2021 Asian Youth and Juniors Championships will be organized and conducted by the SAMBO Union of Asia [SUA] and hosted by the SAMBO Association of Uzbekistan.

1.3 The 2021 Asian SAMBO Championship for Adults and the 2021 Asian Youth and Juniors Championship will welcome and permit the participation of Officials and Athletes of FIAS recognized National Sambo federations from the Continent of Oceania in accordance to the guidelines of the Olympic Council of Asia and as was resolved by the SUA General Body in 2019.

1.4 These Championships are organized so as to popularize and develop SAMBO as an Olympic Sport in Asia and also across Oceania and thus strengthen international sporting relations across the continents.

### 2. Dates and Venue.

The 2021 FIAS Asia/ Oceania Referee Certification Seminar will take place from the 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2021 and the 2021 Asian SAMBO championship will take place from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> June 2021 and the 2021 at the Universal Sports Palace Stadium , at Tashkent . The 2021 FIAS Asia/ Oceania Coaches Certification Seminar will take place from the 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> June 2021 at Tashkent UZBEKISTAN as per schedule of events attached herein .

2.1 The designated official hotel for all VIPs, athletes, delegates and officials shall be announced in due course .

### 3. Conditions of participation.

3.1 All National SAMBO Federations [ NSF], affiliated to the SAMBO Union of Asia and all NSF in the continent of Oceania affiliated to the International SAMBO Federation [ FIAS], are eligible to take part in the 2021 Asian SAMBO Championship among Adults and in the Asian Combat SAMBO Championship among Adults and in the 2021 Asian Youth and Juniors SAMBO Championship as well as in the FIAS seminars.



3.2 Composition of each National Team shall be as per prevalent FIAS / SUA regulations

3.3 **Registration of the athletes shall be made by means of the FIAS Electronic System (FIAS Database) at <https://fms.sambo.sport/registration>** Each National Sambo Federation should have a login ID, a password and FIAS will give the instructions on how to use the Database. Admission of the athletes to the competitions will be carried out through the Database. All questions related to the registration in FIAS Database should be addressed directly to FIAS at [info@sambo-fias.com](mailto:info@sambo-fias.com) or by contacting Tel: +7 4954116137.

3.4 The Championship entry forms with each individual details and total number of all participants **should be also be sent** by each National SAMBO Federation to Asian Championship Organizing Committee, by email to [info@sambo.asia](mailto:info@sambo.asia) and/or [suresh@sambo.asia](mailto:suresh@sambo.asia) and to [uzbek\\_sambo@mail.ru](mailto:uzbek_sambo@mail.ru) but no later than **15<sup>th</sup> May 2021**.

3.5 The SAMBO Association of Uzbekistan will provide the requisite visa support only to those National delegations, which provide the Entry Lists of participants along with scanned clear copies of their valid passports and photos, in a timely manner, but **no later than 15<sup>th</sup> May 2021**

3.6 The SAMBO Association of Uzbekistan, will provide to and airport transfer from Tashkent Airport to the official Hotel at a **cost of USD 20.00 per participant** and hotel accommodation with breakfast and dinner during period of the SUA/FIAS Seminars and during the SUA Asian Championship [only at designated official hotels] along with local conveyance from hotel to venue at Tashkent for all participants, at a consolidated **all inclusive cost of USD 100 per participant per night**. Any additional stay or expenditure will have to be borne personally by the individual participant.

3.7 The application forms for accommodation and airport transfer should be submitted to the Asian Championship Organizing Committee [info@sambo.asia](mailto:info@sambo.asia) and/or [suresh@sambo.asia](mailto:suresh@sambo.asia) and to [uzbek\\_sambo@mail.ru](mailto:uzbek_sambo@mail.ru) no later than **15<sup>th</sup> MAY 2021**. In case of late submission of hotel accommodation **after the deadline of 15<sup>th</sup> MAY 2021**, the cost of accommodation per person per night plus airport transfer and local conveyance during the competition will be increased to USD 170.00 per day. **Due to the COVID-19 restrictions and isolation norms, all participants have to be accommodated in the designated hotels only.**

3.8 The entry forms for the athletes' registration in each weight category should be submitted to the Asian Championship Organizing Committee no later than **15<sup>th</sup> MAY 2021**.

3.9 According to the prevalent FIAS Competition Rules and Regulations, all competitors of in any FIAS competitions must affix a **Back Number Patch** on their SAMBO jackets (for both red and blue jackets) indicating surname and name (no more than 12 letters) as well as the country code of the competitor. The Back Number Patches must be self-arranged by the concerned National Sambo Federation in accordance to FIAS Specifications. **Athletes who do not have a back number affixed on the back of their SAMBO jackets will not be allowed to compete.**

3.10 Each Asia and Oceania member federation will be permitted to enter a maximum of TWO athletes per weight and per age category for Sport Sambo and Combat Sambo Championship events

3.11 Junior Athletes (age 18-20 years) taking part in the Junior Championships would also be permitted to take part in Adult Sport n Combat championship events.

3.12 Junior and Adult athletes participating in Sport Sambo Championship events will also be permitted to take part in Combat Sambo Championship events, provided that such Combat Sambo bouts schedules do not clash and DO NOT take place on the same Championship day.

3.13 It is mandatory for all participants, delegates, officials and athletes to abide by and comply in full with the COVID-19 prevention and precautionary protocols that will be in force through out the duration of the 2021 Asian SAMBO championships and Seminars at Tashkent.



#### 4. Technical specifications of the Championship

##### 4.1 AGE and WEIGHT categories:

\* Article 4, Clause 3. Contestants shall be admitted in accordance with this Regulation. In addition, athletes involved in competitions having the closest year of birth shall be permitted to join a given age group.

4.2 The Asian Championship Host Organizing Committee guarantees first aid / medical attention and ambulance provision to all the participants of each National SAMBO delegation.

4.3 The Asian Championships are held in the individual event as per the Olympic system, with the "repechage" of the semi-finalists. Team places are defined according to the total number of prize places.



4.4 All participants, coaches, referees and representatives must carry with them **original COVID PCR Negative test report issued within 48 hours prior to departure** by their Government authorized testing laboratories of their Nation and each one must also be covered under a medical insurance policy that is valid in Uzbekistan for enter Uzbekistan . All Delegates, Officials and All Athletes must **take at PCR Negative at Tashkent and must mandatorily present a Negative PCR test report during Registration and Accreditation. Another PCR test must also be taken by all participants one day prior to their departure date from Uzbekistan as set by the Ministry of Public Health of the Republic of Uzbekistan. Cost of PCR test at Tashkent is USD 30.00 per person per test.** The validity of the PCR test report and the medical insurance will be checked at arrival and at the weigh-in. Athletes without a valid PCR Negative Test Report and a valid medical insurance cover will not be allowed to participate in the Asian championship.

4.5 Only international category referees under the FIAS / SUA invitation with a corresponding license for the current year 2021 are able to officiate the Championships.

4.6 All heads of delegations must bring with them an audio recording of their respective national anthem (in a CD / Flash Drive) along with 2 sets of their National flags (1 X 2 meters).

## 5. Financial terms and rates

5.1 The SAMBO Association of Uzbekistan will provide to and fro airport transfer from Tashkent International Airport to the Official Hotel at a **cost of USD 20.00 per participant** and hotel accommodation with breakfast and dinner [only at designated official hotels] and local conveyance to venue at Tashkent for all participants of the 2021 SUA/ FIAS Seminars and for the 2021 Asian SAMBO Championship at a consolidated **all inclusive cost of USD 100 per participant per night.** Any additional stay or expenditure will have to be borne personally by the individual participant.

5.2 The SAMBO Association of Uzbekistan shall provide three meals and free VIP hotel accommodation for the FIAS President and /or Two FIAS representatives , FIAS Chief Executive, FIAS Executive Director , the SUA Secretary General , the SUA Director General and also for the Chief Referee , the Chief Secretary [Single Occupancy rooms] and for a maximum 16 FIAS/ SUA certified referees [Double Occupancy rooms ], in accordance with the FIAS / SUA Regulations.

5.3 Return air fare costs from each of the National participants from their home nation to Tashkent International Airport in Tashkent, Uzbekistan are to be self funded by the concerned National Sambo Federation or by the individual participant.

5.4 Uzbekistan visa fees for entry into Uzbekistan, as may be applicable for each participant, are to be self funded by the concerned National Sambo Federation or by the individual participant. The cost of the visa fee may vary depending on the country and can be checked here: <https://mfa.uz/ru/pages/visa-republic-uzb>

5.5 Effective 2021, all participating athletes must have a valid the FIAS Athletes license which costs USD 60.00 and includes an international sports insurance for the select competitions in the FIAS calendar. Each participant who has paid the fee of USD 60.00 for the FIAS license will automatically receive an internationally valid medical sports insurance [ if applicable] . According to the insurance program rules it is not prohibited to have another insurance but the price for FIAS license will remain as USD 60.00 per participant.

5.6 The cost of the FIAS license is 60 USD, which also includes international sports insurance for the selected FIAS competitions. These competitions that are included in the list of FIAS international competitions selected for the 2021 insurance program (the terms and conditions of Insurance are provided upon the request of the NSF at [info@sambo-fias.com](mailto:info@sambo-fias.com), (the NSF is responsible for informing of athletes and officials with the Insurance Rules in advance). Each participant paying 60 USD for the FIAS license fee is automatically included into the insurance programme and gets medical sports insurance. According to the insurance programme rules it is not prohibited to have another insurance but the price for license will remain 60 USD. Any other member of the team (officials), also wishing to be included in the FIAS insurance programme. may do so. by making the requisite payment amount



**License payment and insurance of participants of the Competitions should be executed by the National Sambo Federations whose teams take part in the Competitions.**

5.7 FIAS shall pay a per diem compensation to the Chief Referee and to the Chief Secretary at the rate of 100 US dollars for each day of competitions, including the days of arrival and departure. FIAS shall pay a per diem to the 16 referees/ ITOs at the rate of 50 US dollars for each day of competitions.

5.8 The management, officials, representatives and volunteers of the International Sambo Federation [FIAS], the SAMBO Union of Asia [ SUA ] and the Sambo Association of Uzbekistan [ as the host organizing Authority] shall NOT in anyway whatsoever be held liable to meet or contribute towards any additional expenses that may be incurred by any team member or official participating in this 2021 Asian Championships or the 2021 SUA Referee and Coaches Seminar at Uzbekistan.

## **6. Awarding of Medals to the winners**

6.1 All winners will be awarded with medals and diplomas. Team winners will be awarded with medals and the Asian Winners Cup.

6.2 Medal Winning competitors should wear the red SAMBO uniform at all official ceremonies of the Asian SAMBO Championship

6.3 The national anthem will be played and the national flag will be raised in honor of the winners.

## **7. Anti-Doping**

7.1 The doping tests are carried out by the official Anti-Doping organization or sample collection provider recognized and approved by WADA. The selection of athletes would be according to the 2021 FIAS Anti-Doping rules which are based on 2021 WADA Anti-Doping Code.

After receipt of notification until arrival at the point of doping control the selected athletes will be always accompanied by the official representative of the organization. The selected athlete has right to be accompany by one representative who helps him with translation. The official language during the doping control is English. If the Organizing Committee does not provide participants with accreditation with the photo on it, the selected athlete will be required to provide a valid passport or identity document at the point of doping control. All athletes are required to plan in advance the date and the time of their departure from the competitions taking into consideration that any athlete could be chosen for doping test.

## **8. Terms and Regulations**

8.1 The 2021 Asian Championship is to be carried out in accordance with the FIAS Regulations in accordance to the Preparation and Staging of the Official Competitions (sports and organizational rules) and the International SAMBO Competitions Rules.

8.2 The representatives of the National SAMBO Federations will be admitted to the VIP area only if he/she is attired in formal clothing and admission in sportswear will be restricted. In order to provide well-organized championship for all the participants, entry forms and applications should be completed with all details and dispatched in time to the Organizing Committee and to SUA
