## REGULATIONS

**2025 Asia and Oceania SAMBO Championships**  
**Sport SAMBO for the Blind and Visually Impaired Male**  
**Sport and Combat SAMBO for Adults M/F**  
**Sport and Combat SAMBO for Juniors M/F**  
**Sport Sambo for Youth and Cadets M/F**  
**Sport SAMBO among Masters Male**

**11<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> April 2025**  
**at Tashkent, Republic of Uzbekistan**

### 1. Goals and objectives.

Development and popularization of SAMBO in the Republic of Uzbekistan and in the international arena.  
Improving professional skills and competitiveness of athletes.

Wide involvement of the population in systematic sports activities, promotion of a healthy lifestyle.

The 2025 Asia and Oceania SAMBO Championships are organized with the aim of popularizing and developing SAMBO as an Olympic sport in Asia for both Youth and Adult athletes.

### 2. Competition organizers.

The general management of the organization and conduct of the 2025 SUAO Continental Sport and Combat SAMBO for Adults M / F, Sport and Combat SAMBO for Juniors M/F, Sport SAMBO Youth and Cadets M/ F and Sport SAMBO among Masters Males and Sport SAMBO for the Blind / Visually Impaired will be organized and conducted by the SAMBO Union of Asia & Oceania [SUAO] and hosted by the Uzbekistan SAMBO Association

### 3. Dates and venue.

The competitions are to be held from 14<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> April 2025 at the Sports complex "**Uzbekistan**", Iftikhor str, 1, Yunusabad District, Tashkent, 100057, Tashkent, Republic of Uzbekistan.

### 4. Participants and conditions of the competition.

4.1 Competitions are held in accordance with the prevalent Organization and FIAS Competition Rules (sports and organizational rules) of the International SAMBO Federation [FIAS] (hereinafter referred to as the Rules).

All National SAMBO Federations that are members of good standing of the SAMBO Union of Asia and Oceania have the right to take part in the 2025 Asia & Oceania Continental SAMBO Championships.

The composition of each national team must comply with the current FIAS/ SUAO rules.

Maximum number of athletes for **Adult, Junior, Youth and Cadet** events per participating country: **ONE** athlete in each weight category.

**4.3** The teams **SAMBO among Masters** consist of 5 age groups and 7 weight categories as under:

Weight categories: 64, 71, 79, 88, 98, + 98kg

Age Categories:

- M-1 35 – 39 years (born 1990 – 1986)
- M-2 40 – 44 years (born 1985 – 1981)
- M-3 45 – 49 years (born 1980 – 1976)
- M-4 50 – 54 years (born 1975 – 1971)
- M-5 55 – 59 years (born 1970 – 1966)
- M-6 60 – 64 years (born 1965-1961)
- M-7 65 years and older (born 1960)

NOTE: Maximum number permissible participants per NSF is **FOUR** athletes in each weight/ age category per Nation.

4.4. SAMBO for the **Blind and Visually Impaired** consist of 2 groups of Visually Impaired Adult Male athletes in 5 weight categories as under:

1. Class **SVI-1** (Adult Male) Weight: up to 64 kg; up to 71 kg; up to 79 kg; up to 88 kg; up to 98 kg.
2. Class **SVI-2** (Adult Male) Weight up to 64 kg; up to 71 kg; up to 79 kg; up to 88 kg; up to 98 kg.

**NOTE:** Maximum number permissible participants per NSF is **TWO** athletes in each SV1 and SV2 weight categories per Nation.

4.5 All Blind and Visually Impaired participants must register their entries on FIAS data base by the deadline of 14<sup>th</sup> March 2025.

4.6 Classification procedure for Blind and Visually Impaired Athletes

All Blind and Visually Impaired Athletes must submit a completed **Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF)** to [newmoscow80@yandex.ru](mailto:newmoscow80@yandex.ru) and to [oybek27fayzibaev@gmail.com](mailto:oybek27fayzibaev@gmail.com) by 14.03.2025 .

MDF forms completed in a language other than English will be rejected. Participants are given 1 week to correct an incorrectly completed form.

Blind and Visually Impaired Athletes must be classified prior to weighing in. During classification, a completed classification form for athletes with visual impairments (blind and visually impaired) must be provided to classifiers before the start of the evaluation.

Items 1, 2, 3 of this form must be filled in by the concerned National SAMBO Federation and their athlete before the classification. The athlete's consent form and the confidential obligations of the accompanying person and translator, which are attached to the classification form, must be read before the classification, but signed only during the classification.

All required manual forms will be set to each SUA Member.

4.7 **Entry Fees:** Participants who have not been accredited and do not have accreditation cards are not allowed to participate in the competitions. All participants among the **Masters category** must pay a participation fee of **USD \$100.00 per participant directly to the SAMBO Union of Asia & Oceania at the time of accreditation.**

#### **4.8 Visa Support**

Participants who require a visa to enter Uzbekistan must apply for a visa from the appropriate Uzbekistan embassy/consulate in their home countries. The Organizing Committee will provide the necessary visa support subject to receipt of prior notification **up to 14<sup>th</sup> March 2025 ONLY**. Participating countries must provide detailed lists of participants along with scanned, clear copies of their valid passports and high-resolution photographs and complete **the visa support application form and send by email** to [uzbek\\_SAMBO@mail.ru](mailto:uzbek_SAMBO@mail.ru), and to **no later than 14<sup>th</sup> March , 2025** .

#### **4.9 Accommodation and Transfer Fees**

The Organizing Committee will provide transfer from Tashkent International Airport to the official hotels at a cost of **USD \$20.00 for each participant**. Accommodation in official hotels including breakfast and dinner, along with local roundtrip transportation from the hotel to the competition venue in Tashkent for all participants, will cost a total of **USD \$100.00 per participant per night in a double occupancy room**. The price for **a single occupancy** room with breakfast and dinner is **USD \$150** per night per person. Any additional accommodation or expenses must be paid personally by each participant.

**NOTE: Room Booking form with dates and time of arrival / departure - deadline 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2025{ Appendix No.2 ] must be submitted by each NSF on or before 14<sup>th</sup> March 2025 to the SUAO official hotel booking authority by email to [suao2025@gmail.com](mailto:suao2025@gmail.com)**

In case of late application for hotel accommodation **after the deadline of 14<sup>th</sup> March 2025**, the cost of accommodation per person per night plus airport - hotel - arena transfer during the competition will be increased **to USD \$150 per night for a double room** and a **single room USD \$200 per night**.

#### **4.10 Registration**

Registration of teams for all competitions is carried out through the FIAS online system (FIAS Database) at: <https://fms.SAMBO.sport/login> . To enter the personal account of each NFS, you need a login and password for the system, as well as instructions for using the system. Athletes are admitted only through the FIAS System. For questions regarding registration in the FIAS Database, please directly contact the FIAS office: tel. +7 (495) 411-61-37, [info@SAMBO.sport](mailto:info@SAMBO.sport) . The deadline for online registration of athletes and coaches on the FIAS Database is **14<sup>th</sup> March 2025**.

Every athlete and coach are required to register in the FIAS database and obtain a FIAS license with payment of the membership fee for the current year. The cost of a FIAS **annual license is USD \$60 per person**, which also includes international sports insurance for a specific list of competitions on the FIAS Calendar.

These competitions are included in the list of FIAS international competitions included in the insurance program for 2025 (insurance conditions can be found upon request to the NSF at [info@SAMBO.sport](mailto:info@SAMBO.sport) : the NSF is responsible for familiarizing athletes and officials with the Insurance Rules in advance) .

National SAMBO federations must ALSO send completed forms **Appendix 1. and Appendix 2.** signed by the President or General Secretary with the seal of the Federation, and a copy of their national anthem (no more than 1 minute in mp3 format) to the Organizing Committee of the Championship by e-mail to [uzbek\\_SAMBO@mail.ru](mailto:uzbek_SAMBO@mail.ru) , and to [suao2025@gmail.com](mailto:suao2025@gmail.com) **no later than 14<sup>th</sup>March 2025**

#### **4.11 Back Patch on Uniforms**

In accordance with the current FIAS Competition Rules, all participants must attach to the back of their SAMBO competition jackets (both red and blue jackets) a patch indicating their last name (no more than 12 letters), as well as the code of the participant's country. The patch must be sewn/attached by the relevant National SAMBO Federation in accordance with FIAS specifications **PRIOR to their arrival** in Tashkent. Athletes who do not have a patch on the back of their SAMBO jackets will not be allowed to compete.

#### **5. Competition Rules and Regulations**

Competitions are held in accordance with the prevalent FIAS Organization and Competition Rules and Regulations (Sports Organizational Rules). Judging/ Refereeing of all competitions is entrusted to a panel of Referees approved by FIAS/SUAO.

Only Referees certified and appointed by FIAS/SUAO and holding a valid FIAS license for 2025 are allowed to officiate in these competitions.

Sports SAMBO competitions are held with elimination and "repechage" from among the finalists; Combat SAMBO competitions are held without "repechage". Determination of places in the team standings is carried out according to the Olympic principle (by the number of gold, silver and bronze medals).

The Organizing Committee guarantees the provision of first aid to all participants during the entire duration of the competition, both in official hotels and in the arena (if necessary).

## **6. Medal Awarding**

All winners will be awarded medals and diplomas. Participants who have won medals are required to wear the red SAMBO uniform at all official Medal Awarding ceremonies.

## **7. Anti-Doping**

Mandatory Doping controls shall be carried out by ITA / Anti-Doping Organization accredited by WADA. Athletes to be tested will be selected in accordance with the requirements of the FIAS Anti-Doping Rules 2021 which are based on the 2021 WADA Code.

From the time of notification until an arrival to the Doping Control Station, the selected athletes will be accompanied by chaperone trained by the Anti-Doping Organization responsible for sample collection at the event.

The selected athlete may also be accompanied by one (1) representative to assist him or her with translation. The official language to be used during the doping control procedure shall be English. If the Organizing Committee does not provide accreditation with photo of the athlete, the selected athlete will be required to present a valid passport or other identification document at the Doping Control Station. **All athletes are required to plan the date and time of their departure in consideration they may be selected for doping control.**

All costs of Anti- Doping testing shall be borne by solely the Organizing Committee of the Uzbekistan SAMBO Association.

The Anti-Doping Seminar will be held on 15 April 2025, at the at the Sports complex "**Uzbekistan**", Tashkent, at 3pm and participation in the same **is mandatory for all Athlete Support Personnel.**

All athletes are also invited to attend the seminar and follow the WADA outreach programme during the even

## **8. Financial terms.**

Heads of National sports delegations must settle all pending financial obligations with the Organizing Committee and to SUA0, on the day of arrival and fulfil all accreditation requirements.

FIAS shall pay the Chief Referee and the Chief Secretary of this event a daily allowance for each day of competition, including days of arrival and departure along with a daily allowance for a maximum of 20 referees/ITOs for each day of competition including the SUA0 Medical Officer.

Free hotel accommodation with meals and free transportation shall also be covered for the Chief Referee, the Chief Secretary [Single Occupancy rooms] and for a maximum of 20 FIAS certified ITOs [Double Occupancy] accordance with the FIAS / SUA0 Regulations.

The SAMBO Association of Uzbekistan shall provide free VIP hotel accommodation with three meals per day, along with **dedicated transport** for the SUA0 Director General [Chief Technical Delegate] and for FIAS VIPs.

The Uzbekistan SAMBO Association shall provide return airfare, free VIP hotel accommodation with meals and a **dedicated transport** for the SUA0 Technical Delegate for his detailed inspection visit to Tashkent city, 15 days prior to the Championship.

## **9. Accreditation.**

All participants must go through the accreditation procedure, which will take place at the official hotel at Tashkent.

During the accreditation procedure, All National team leaders shall provide the following documents to the Registration Committee:

Manual Entry forms as per age / weight categories [ Appendix No.1], original passport or identity card, 2 sets of national flags (1 x 2 meters), USB drive with the national anthem (not longer than 1 minute duration), medical insurance policy (original).
