REGULATIONS
of the A.A.Kharlampiev Memorial –
SAMBO World Cup
(men and women, men in Combat SAMBO)

Moscow-2015

1. Goals of the competitions

- to popularise SAMBO in the world;
- to improve sports skills of athletes;
- the World Cup event

2. Date and venue

A.A.Kharlampiev Memorial – SAMBO World Cup (men and women, men in Combat SAMBO) (hereinafter - the Competitions) is held in Moscow from March 26 to March 30, 2015, including the day of arrival on March 26, 2015, the day of departure on March 30, 2015.

3. Competitions Management

General management of the preparation and holding the Competitions is arranged by the International SAMBO Federation (hereinafter - the FIAS), Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation (hereinafter - the Minsport of Russia), All-Russian SAMBO Federation All-Russian Physical Education and Sports Public Organisation (hereinafter - the Federation), Department of Physical Education and Sports of the city of Moscow (hereinafter - the Moskomspor) and the Moscow SAMBO Federation Regional Public Organisation (hereinafter - the Moscow SAMBO Federation).

The powers of the Ministry of Sports of Russia as the organiser of the international competitions are exercised by the Management on Organisation and Conduct of Sports Events Federal Government Autonomous Institution.

Direct responsibility for conducting the competitions is rested on the Panel of Judges approved by Chairman of the FIAS Committee of Judges.

4. Participants and Conducting Conditions

The Competitions are held in accordance with the Regulations of the organisation and conduct of the FIAS official competitions (hereinafter - the Regulations).

The Competitions are held in the following weight categories:

- men – 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, over 100 kg;
- women – 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, over 80 kg;
- men in Combat SAMBO – 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, over 100 kg.

Athletes (not younger than 1997) of sports teams of the FIAS member countries participate in the Competitions.

Composition of the delegation – 32 people, including athletes – 27 people, coaches – 3 people, physicians – 1 person, team leader – 1 person.

Number of athletes from a country is not more than 1 in each weight category.

Only athletes who have a FIAS licence book with a stamp confirming payment of the FIAS annual licence for 2015 are qualified for participation in the Competitions. Athletes who arrive to the tournament without having timely paid for the licence shall pay for the annual licence (25 US dollars) on the spot. Athletes who do not have a licence book on hand may purchase one at the Treasure or his authorised person for 10 US dollars.

5. Summarising

Rules of bouts and the Competitions winners and medalists determination is carried out in accordance with the international SAMBO rules. The Competitions are personal.

6. Awarding

Winners and medalists of the Competitions in each weight category are awarded with the FIAS medals, diplomas and cups.

Other organisations may provide additional awards and commemorative prizes.

7. Accreditation

For getting accreditation mass media representatives should first complete the appropriate form in the section Media Centre – Accreditation on the FIAS official website www.sambo-fias.org, specifying in the Comments section the Competitions title – A.A.Kharlampiev Memorial World SAMBO Cup. The form should be completed no later than March 20, 2015.

When undergoing the accreditation procedure Heads shall submit FIAS licence with the stamp confirming the Federation annual fee payment to the Secretariat of the Competition.

8. Press

The Event Organising Committee provides all the necessary conditions for the representatives of press at the Event in accordance with the FIAS Guidelines for Press.

9. Television

All rights for the television broadcast of the Event belong to the FIAS. The Organising Committee provides the Event broadcast in accordance with the FIAS Guidelines for Television.

10. Marketing and Advertising

The Event Organising Committee guarantees the sponsorship rights for the FIAS partners and sponsors, stipulated in the FIAS Guidelines for Marketing.

11. Financial Conditions

The International SAMBO Federation, Ministry of Sports of Russia, All-Russian SAMBO Federation and Moscow SAMBO Federation, Minsport of Russia, Moskomspor provide equity participation in the Competitions funding as agreed.

Transportation of the participants is at the sending organisation expense.

Heads of sports delegations have to settle all financial obligations with the Organising Committee on the day of arrival and fulfill all the requirements for accreditation.

FIAS incurs travel expenses of Chief Judge and Chief Secretary of the Competitions and pay them salary at the rate of 100 US dollars for each day of the Competitions including arrival and departure days, as well as the salaries of 25 judges at the rate of 50 US dollars for each day of the Competitions.

12. Safety Provisions

The Competitions are held at the sports venue included in the All-Russian Register of sports facilities, in accordance with the Federal Law of December 4, 2007 No. 329-FZ “On Physical Culture and Sports in the Russian Federation” complying with the relevant laws and regulations in force on the territory of the Russian Federation aimed at peacekeeping and safety of participants and spectators, as well as meeting the requirements of the Regulations.

13. Participants Insurance

Participation in the Competitions is carried out only upon availability of supporting documents on the life and health insurance against accidents at each participant.

The Organising Committee is provided with the original of the insurance.

Competitors insurance is made at the expense of countries participating in the Competitions.

14. Procedure and Deadline for Applications

Applications for participation in the Competitions are submitted to the national federations no later than March 8, 2015.
