



**WORLD CUP STAGE REGULATIONS
FOR THE PRIZE OF THE MAYOR OF BURGAS
Sport sambo (men and women) and combat sambo
September 05-08, 2014
Town of Burgas, Bulgaria**

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

The general management, preparation and holding of the sambo World Cup is performed by the Ministry of Youth and Sports, the Bulgarian Sambo Federation, the International Sambo Federation (FIAS) and the Municipality of Burgas.

The organization and holding of the tournament is assigned to a panel of referees approved by FIAS Referee Commission.

2. TIME AND VENUE

The tournament is to be held from September 5th to September 8th 2014 in the town of Burgas – Republic of Bulgaria.

Team accreditation venue: AQUA Hotel, located in the town of Burgas, Democratsia Blvd, Lazur Compound

The organizing committee has booked two hotels to accommodate for the tournament participants:

- AQUA Hotel, town of Burgas, Democratsia Blvd, Lazur Compound
- Mirage Hotel, town of Burgas, 93 Slaveykov Compound

Tournament Venue – Bulgaria, town of Burgas, Mladost Sports Hall – town of Burgas, Slaveykov Compound

3. CONDITIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

The best teams in the world from federations that are members of FIAS are invited to take part in the World Cup.

Only those participants who have been licensed by FIAS for 2014 are eligible for the tournament. The license fee is 25 US dollars and is paid by the national federation 1 month before the start of the tournament in case an athlete has a FIAS license book.

Participants arriving for the World Cup that have not paid for their licenses can pay for an annual license on website (a fee of 25 US dollars) completing the accreditation. Contestants who don't have license book may purchase them from the treasurer or any person authorized by the treasurer. To fill in the license book one needs a photo and 10 US dollars for its purchase.

Contestants must have medical insurance for the period of the tournament.

4. APPLICATION FORMS

5. TECHNICAL TERMS

The tournament is to be held in compliance with the International Sambo Rules and the International Sambo Federation (FIAS) Regulations regarding the preparation and holding of international tournaments.

Weight categories:

Men: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg

Women: 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, +80 kg

Combat sambo: 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100 kg

The organizing committee guarantees first medical aid assistance to all participants in the World Cup.

6. PRIZES

6.1 Top ranked contestants will be awarded with diplomas and medals relevant to their ranking.

7. FINANCIAL TERMS

Any costs related to accommodation and food for the team members will be covered by the Bulgarian Sambo Federation amounting to 50% of the total number of athletes from each team.

Example: If a team consists of 24 contestants, then the costs for 12 of them will be covered by the Bulgarian Sambo Federation.

National federations with excessive numbers of team members must separately pay an amount of 50€ per day per person for accommodation, food and transfer. Any additional stay (days before and after the tournament, dates announced) must also be paid for by national federations for their entire teams.

A transfer from the airport/railway station to the hotel costs 20 US dollars per person. Transfers from the hotel to the sports hall and back will be covered by the Bulgarian Sambo Federation.

Team managers must settle all financial liabilities with the organizing committee on the day of arrival and meet all accreditation requirements.

The organizing committee is to cover all costs related to accommodation, food and transfers from the airport/railway station in Burgas to the hotel and back on tournament days incurred by FIAS President, FIAS Chief Secretary, Chief Treasurer, Chief Referee and the World Cup Chief Secretary.

FIAS is to pay for transportation of FIAS Treasurer, Chief Referee and Chief Secretary from their places of residence to the town of Burgas and back and FIAS will also pay 100 US dollars per day for their work, including the days of arrival and departure.



FIAS pays for the work of 18 (eighteen) referees 50 US dollars per tournament day. Only international referees are eligible for participating in the event.

Accommodation and food for 18 (eighteen) referees will be covered by the organizing committee.

8. ACCREDITATION

All participants must go through an accreditation procedure. It is to be held in the town of Burgas at the AQUA Hotel, Democratsia Blvd, Lazur Compound.

During the accreditation procedure all team managers must provide to the tournament secretary's office the following documents: weight category application form; passport or any other ID; FIAS license with the confirmation of paid annual fee; national flag (1 x 2 m), 2 pcs; CD or minidisc containing national anthems; insurance policy (original); 2 photos required for the accreditation.

Media representatives in order to obtain accreditations have to fill in a form in advance in section <Media – center> - <Accreditation> on FIAS official website <http://sambo-fias.org/pages/accreditation>, section <Commentaries> name of tournament – Sambo World Cup (individual) for men and women and combat sambo. The form is to be filled not later than July 25th 2014.

9. VISA ASSISTANCE

All participants of the World Cup will be provided with necessary visa support for applying to visas in Bulgaria consulates.

10. MARKETING AND ADVERTISING

10.1 The organizing committee guarantees the following of FIAS marketing rules and FIAS partners sponsorship requirements in compliance with FIAS marketing guidelines. This document is published on FIAS official website, FIAS section, Documents subsection - <http://sambo-fias.org/pages/dokumenty>.

10.2 The organizing committee guarantees to provide the relevant working conditions for the accredited press representatives during the event in compliance with FIAS requirements, FIAS section, Documents subsection- <http://sambo-fias.org/pages/dokumenty>.

10.3 All broadcasting and distribution rights regarding the event belong to FIAS. The organizing committee must specify a broadcasting company that is to perform web broadcasting on FIAS official website, <http://sambo-fias.org>, and they also have to enter into the relevant agreements in compliance with FIAS TV broadcast guideline.
