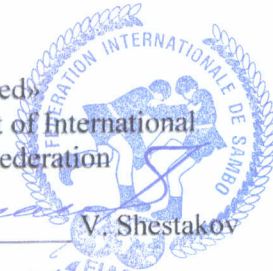

REGULATIONS YOUTH AND JUNIORS WORLD SAMBO CHAMPIONSHIPS 2016

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. Youth and Juniors World SAMBO Championships 2016 (hereinafter referred to as the World SAMBO Championships) shall be held in accordance with the FIAS Regulations on Preparation and Staging of the Official Competitions (sports and organizational rules) and the International SAMBO Competitions Rules.

1.2. World SAMBO Championships shall be held in order to decide on the winner in the corresponding age groups as well as to promote and develop SAMBO worldwide, and strengthen the international relations.

2. COMPETITIONS ORGANISERS

2.1. General management of the organisation and holding of the World SAMBO Championships 2016 shall be the responsibility of the International SAMBO Federation (FIAS) together with Romanian SAMBO Federation with the support of the Ministry of Youth and Sport, Olympic Committee of Romania and Ploesti City administration.

3. DATES AND VENUE

3.1. World SAMBO Championships shall be held from 6 to 10 October 2016.

3.2. Competition venue: Olimpia Sports Hall, 100051, Strada Maresal Averescu, Ploiesti, Romania.

3.3. Accreditation will take place at the Hotel «CENTRAL», 100008, Bulevardul Republicii nr.1, Ploiesti, Romania.

3.4. Participants will be accommodated in:

- Hotel “CENTRAL”, 100008, Bulevardul Republicii nr.1.
- Hotel “PRAHOVA PLAZA”, 100035, str. C-tin Dobrogeanu Gherea nr.11.
- Hotel “VIGO HOTEL”, Bulevardul Independentei nr.28.

4. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

4.1. Those athletes who are affiliated to their National SAMBO Federations at the age of 17-18 (1998-1999, Youth, M&W) and 19-20 years of age (1996-1997, Juniors, M&W) are able to participate at the championships.

Athletes should have FIAS license book with a corresponding seal confirming payment for the FIAS annual license for 2016. Athletes arriving for participation at the competitions without having timely paid for the FIAS annual license shall pay for the annual license (25 US dollars) on site. Athletes without the license book on hand may purchase it for 10 US dollars from the Treasurer or a person authorised by him.

All the athletes should have sports medical insurance. Athletes of 2000 year of birth in order to participate should have written permission of a doctor in English.

5. TECHNICAL TERMS

5.1. World SAMBO Championships shall be held in accordance with FIAS Sport and Organization Rules and the International SAMBO Competitions Rules. Refereeing of the competitions shall be entrusted to the panel of referees approved by the Chairman of FIAS Referees Commission.

5.2. Only international category referees who were appointed by the Chairman of FIAS Referees Commission are able to referee the competitions. Each referee should have a corresponding license for the current year 2016.

5.3. Repechage system from semi-finalists is applied what means that a competitor who loses to the pool semi-finalists drops into the repechage bracket. Team medal count is conducted according to the gold first ranking system (based first on the number of gold medals, then silver and bronze).

5.4 Participation in the competition is allowed only if each athlete has a medical insurance to be submitted to the Mandate Commission of the competitions. Competition participants are insured at the expense of the sending organisation.

5.5. The Organizing Committee guarantees to provide all the participants with the first aid (if necessary).

5.6. According to the FIAS Regulations on Preparation and Staging of the Official Competitions - Appendix 7 (page 24) each competitor is obliged to have (sewn/ironed) on the back of his uniforms (red & blue) a back-number comprising his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The back-number can be ordered only from the companies who duly follow the FIAS Regulations such as www.sambobacknumber.com or others.

5.7. During the accreditation, all the countries' delegates should provide the Organizing Committee with a short version (not more than 30 seconds) of corresponding national anthem in electronic format (soft copy).

6. ANTI-DOPING

Doping controls will be conducted by the National Anti-Doping Organization officially recognized by WADA. The selection of the athletes will be carried out in accordance with the FIAS Anti-Doping Rules 2015 which are based on 2015 WADA Code. The selected athletes will be accompanied by a chaperone of the Organization since the moment when receive the notice until they arrive to the doping control station. A person of the choice of the athletes (the team physician, trainer and head of delegation) can accompany them. In the case of which the Organizing Committee does not provide accreditation card with photography the selected athlete is required to provide to the Doping Control Officer a valid passport or identity document with photography. Please plan your departure from the event with consideration that your athletes may be selected for Doping Control.

7. ENTRIES

7.3. Mass media representatives will pass additional accreditation process at the official FIAS website: <http://sambo-fias.org> in the section Press Centre – Press Accreditation not later than August 20.

8. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

8.1. Each delegation member shall pay a fee at the amount of 100 US dollars per day to the Organizing Committee (accommodation and meals 2 times a day). Minimum accommodation duration is two days.

8.2. The cost of transfer from airport or railway station to the official hotel and back and during competitions from the official hotel to the competition venue and back costs 20 US dollars for each team member and to be paid by the national federations.

8.3. In case of individual reservation of accommodation each national federation shall pay an accreditation fee at the amount of 150 US dollars for each team member (accommodation, meals, transfer are not included in this fee) to the Organizing Committee to cover the cost of organizing the championships.

8.4. All the participants travel to the competition venue at the expense of sending organisations.

8.5. Heads of delegations shall settle all financial issues and meet accreditation requirements on the day of arrival. Payment to be made on site **in US dollars**.

8.6. The Organizing Committee shall provide with accommodation and meals: FIAS President, Secretary General, Chairman of the Referees Commission, Chief Referee, Chief Secretary and 24 referees.

8.7. FIAS shall pay the work of the Chairman of the Referees Commission, Chief Referee and Chief Secretary at the rate of 100 US dollars for each day of competitions, including the days of arrival and departure. FIAS shall pay the work of 24 referees at the rate of 50 US dollars for each day of competitions.

8.8. Those National Federations which failed to send the Entry №4 later than **deadline (September 6)** should pay the fee at the amount of 50 US dollars for each day per each member (accommodation and meals 2 times a day).

9. AWARDING

9.1. Prize-winning athletes shall be awarded with medals, diplomas and presents.

9.2. Red sambo uniform is required at the awarding ceremony.

9.3. During the awarding ceremony national anthem will be played along with flying a flag.

9.4. Prize-winning teams shall be awarded with cups and diplomas.
