TEAM WORLD SAMBO CUP (M&W, COMBAT SAMBO)
UNDER THE PATRONAGE OF PRESIDENT OF MONGOLIA
H.E. MR. H.BATTULGA

Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia

1. Goals of the competitions

- 1.1 Popularization and development of sambo in Mongolia and at the international scale
- 1.2 Strengthening international sports and cultural relations
- 1.3 Promotion of healthy lifestyle

2. Date and venue

Sambo World Cup (M&W, Combat Sambo) is to be held in Ulaanbaatar, the capital city of Mongolia, between 13-15 July 2019. The main venue is Buyant Ukhaa Sports Complex.

3. Management of the competition (hereinafter the tournament)

General management of organization and carrying out of the tournament shall be arranged by International Sambo Federation (FIAS), Office of the President of Mongolia, Ministry of Education, Culture, Sciences and Sports of Mongolia and the Executive office of the Government of Mongolia.

4. Conditions of participation

The Championships shall be held in accordance with FIAS Sports and Organization Rules and the International Sambo Competition Rules. Officiating of the competition shall be entrusted to the panel of referees approved by the Chairman of FIAS Technical Commission.

Weight categories:

- Sport Sambo/men/-68, -74,+100
- Sport Sambo /women/- 48, -56, -68
- Combat Sambo /men/ - 62, -90, +90

Only FIAS member athletes born before 2001 are eligible if they are in the National sambo team of their own countries.

Official delegation for the World Cup shall include 9 athletes, 2 reserve athletes, 2 coaches, 1 doctor, and 1 team coordinator.

Each weight category is represented by ONE athlete only from each country.

Registration of the teams to the competitions is made by means of FIAS online license and competitions registration system at <http://registration.sambo-fias.org/>. Each National Sambo Federation should get a login and a password from FIAS to access the system. Admission of the athletes to the competitions is made only by means of the system. The cost of license is **60 USD**,

which includes **the international sports insurance** for the selected competitions from FIAS calendar. For additional information about registration and insurance, please contact the FIAS office: tel. тел.+7 (495) 411-61-37, info@sambo-fias.com.

5. Entries

Team coordinators are required to submit the payslip of the FIAS membership annual fee to FIAS. They are also expected to submit the team application forms and passport copies of the participants and delegates.

6. Draw

Draw will be conducted manually in public after the weigh-in with random distribution of athletes.

7. Awarding

Prize-winning athletes shall be awarded with medals, diplomas and prize money.

The breakdown of prize money will be the following:

- Gold medalist – 30,000 US dollars;
- Silver medalist – 20,000 US dollars;
- Bronze medalists – 10,000 US dollars each

8. Financial conditions

8.1 Each delegation member must pay the Organizational Fee to the Organizing Committee at the amount of 100 USD per day (accommodation and 2 times a day meal). Minimum accommodation period is two (2) days.

8.2 Transfer fee from Bucharest airport or railway station to the official Championship hotel and back and from official hotel to the competition venue and back is 20 USD for each delegation member during competitions. The cost should be paid at the expense of the NSF.

8.3 In case of individual accommodation (independently from the Organizing Committee) each NSF shall pay an accreditation fee at the amount of 150 USD for each team member (accommodation, meals, transfer are not included in this fee) to the Organizing Committee to cover the cost of Championships organization.

8.4 All the Championship participants travel to the competition venue at the expense of their sending organization.

9. Media

The Organizing Committee of the Event shall provide all necessary conditions for the work of media representatives at the Event in accordance with the FIAS Media Regulations.

10. Television

Eligible partner broadcasters are MNB, ETV and C1. Organizing committee is to ensure that the broadcasting is in accordance with the guidelines set by the FIAS.

11. Marketing and Advertisements

The Organizing Committee shall guarantee compliance with the sponsorship rules provided for in the FIAS Marketing Manual to its partners and FIAS sponsors.

12. Security

The National Police Office is in charge of ensuring the security during the tournament taking place at the Buyant Ukhua Sports Complex.

13. Application submission

Completed entry forms duly sealed and signed by NSF President or Secretary General shall be sent to the Championships Organizing Committee before 20 June 2019.
