REGULATION

2023 European SAMBO Championship for Sports SAMBO Adults (M-F), Combat SAMBO for Adults (M), Sport SAMBO Juniors / Youth / Cadets (M-F) at Haifa, Israel from 18th to 24th of April 2023

1. General terms.

1.1 The European Sambo Championship 2023 (Sport Sambo Adults (M-F) and Combat Sambo for Adults (M)) and the European Sambo Championship 2023 (Sport Sambo Juniors and Youth (M-F)) (hereafter the European Sambo Championships and 2023) are held in accordance with the current international sambo rules adopted by the International SAMBO Federation (FIAS).

1.2 The European Sambo Championship 2023 is held in accordance with the current regulations of the European Sambo Federation (ESF) and International SAMBO Federation (FIAS).

1.3 The European Sambo Championship 2023 will be organized and held by the European Sambo Federation (EFS) and Israel Sambo Federation.

1.4 The European Sambo Championship 2023 is organized to popularize and develop SAMBO as an Olympic Sport in Europe and thus strengthen international sporting relations between the members of the European Sambo Federation (EFS) in Europe.

2. Competition organizers.

2.1 General management of the organization and holding of the European Sambo Championship 2023 shall be the responsibility of the European Sambo Federation (ESF) together with Israel Sambo Federation.

3. Dates and venue.

3.1 The European Sambo Championship 2023 shall be held from 18 to 24 of April 2023.

3.2 Competition venue: ROMEMA SPORTS ARENA, 69 Pika road st, Haifa (Israel).

3.3 Accreditation will take place at the hotel "Almog Haifa" 10 David Elazar st, Haifa.

3.4 Participants will be accommodated in: Almog Haifa hotel & Tower Haifa hotel.

4. Terms of participation.

4.1 The National SAMBO Federations affiliated to European Sambo Federation (ESF) have the right to take part in the Competitions.

4.2 Not more than 1 athletes per weight category from national team is allowed to take part in the competition.

4.3 Registration of the athletes is made ONLY by means of the FIAS Electronic System (FIAS Database) at <https://fms.sambo.sport/login>. Admission of the athletes to the competitions will be carried out through the Database only. All questions related to the registration in FIAS Database should be addressed to FIAS at info@sambo-fias.com or +7(495)4116137 as well as checked at the FIAS YouTube channel: <https://www.youtube.com/playlist?list=PLkng14WT2Qfxg7pq0jh9HplMmmag72sdF>.

4.4 The deadline for registration in the FIAS database is March 31, 2023.

4.5 National federations that fail to submit their entries by March 31, 2023 through the FIAS Database will be obliged to pay the fine of 200 USD per each delegate, who is not registered for the competitions (FIAS Database registration onsite will be obligatory anyway).

4.6 All participants who require a visa to enter Israel must apply for a visa at the Israeli embassy in their respective countries. The Israel Sambo Federation will provide the necessary visa support, subject to prior notification by 31 March 2023.

4.7 Due to the worsening epidemiological situation worldwide and in order to avoid the possible quarantine of the sports delegation for 7 days, the Sambo Federation of Israel recommends not to use regular connecting flights but to use the charter service.

5. Technical specifications.

5.1 The European Sambo Championship 2023 shall be conducted in accordance with the current regulations of the European Sambo Federation (ESF) the International Sambo Federation (FIAS) and the International Sambo Competition Rules. The refereeing of the competitions shall be entrusted to a Panel of referees approved by the refereeing committee of the European Sambo Federation (EFS).

5.2 Only international category referees, who were appointed by the Referee Commission of ESF, will be allowed to referee the competitions.

5.3 The draw will be carried out manually in public after weigh-in with a random distribution of competitors.

5.4 The system of competitions with elimination and repechage from the finalists shall be applied in Sport SAMBO (men and women), and Combat SAMBO competitions shall be conducted without repechage. Team medal standings shall be conducted according to the Olympic principle.

5.5 The Organizing Committee guarantees to provide all the participants with the first aid (if necessary).

5.6 Each athlete must undergo a medical examination before leaving for the competition, the results of the medical examination must be included in the application or medical certificate.

5.7 During the accreditation, all the countries delegates should provide the Organizing Committee with a short version (not more than 30 seconds) of corresponding national anthem in electronic format and two national flags 2x1m.

6. Anti-Doping.

6.1 The doping tests are carried out by the official Anti-Doping organization or sample collection provider recognized and approved by WADA. The selection of athletes would be according to the 2021 FIAS Anti-Doping rules, which are based on 2021 WADA Anti-Doping Code. After receipt of notification until arrival at the point of doping control the selected athletes will be always accompanied by the official specialists of the organization. The selected athlete may be accompanied by a person of their choice (team doctor, coach or head of delegation). If the Organizing Committee does not provide participants with accreditation with the photo on it, the selected athlete will be required to provide a valid passport or identity document at the point of doping control.

6.2 The teams' representatives must carefully plan their departure date and time after the competition taking into account that the athletes may be chosen for the Doping Control.

7. Financial conditions.

7.1 Each National Sambo Federation must pay an annual membership fee to the European Sambo Federation in the amount of 300 (three hundred) euro according to the regulations of the European Sambo Federation (ESF). National Sambo Federations which do not pay the annual fee will not be allowed to compete.

7.2 Israel Sambo Federation will provide transfer from Ben Gurion International Airport to the official hotel and back at the price of 20,00 Euro per participant and transfer from the official hotels to the competition venue and back.

7.3 Israel Sambo Federation will provide hotel accommodation with breakfast and dinner (only in the specified official hotels) at the rate of 100,00 Euro per participant per night (double occupancy) and 150,00 Euro per person for single occupancy for the entire period of the European Sambo Championships 2023. Any additional stays or expenses must be paid personally by each participant. The accommodation period is 2 days minimum for each delegation member (official hotels only).

7.4 Heads of Delegations must fulfill all financial obligations to the Organizing Committee on the day of arrival and meet all conditions for accreditation.

7.5 Delegation members who arrived but were not included in the final application by March 31, 2023, will be required to pay 150,00 Euro per day of accommodation for each participant.

7.6 The Organizing Committee provides food and accommodation for the President of the European Sambo Federation (ESF), the Secretary General of the European Sambo Federation (ESF), the Head of the Referee Commission of the European Sambo Federation (ESF), the Chief Referee, the Chief Secretary and 20 judges in accordance with the rules of the European Sambo Federation (ESF).

7.7 Each athlete is obliged to register in the FIAS Database and have a FIAS license with the payment of the membership fee for the current year. The cost of the FIAS license is 60 USD, which also includes international sports insurance for a certain list of competitions in the FIAS Calendar. These competitions are included in the list of international FIAS competitions included in the insurance program for 2023 (the terms and conditions of the Insurance are available on request from National Sambo Federations (NSF) at info@sambo-fias.com; it is the responsibility of the National Sambo Federations (NSF) to familiarize the athletes and officials with the Insurance Regulations in advance). Every participant who has paid the FIAS license fee of 60 USD is automatically included in the insurance program and receives medical sports insurance. The rules of the insurance program do not prohibit having any other insurance, but the license fee remains the same at 60 USD. License fees and competitors' insurance are paid by the National Sambo Federations (NSF) whose national teams take part in the Competitions. Competitors who have not registered in the FIAS Database and have not paid their membership fee for the current year will not be admitted to the European Sambo Championship 2023.

7.8 Each National SAMBO Federation's coach should have a FIAS coaches' certificate and cover the cost of license – 60 USD, which includes the international sports insurance for the selected competitions from FIAS calendar.

7.9 International Sambo Federation (FIAS) pays a salary to the chief referee and chief secretary in the amount of 100 USD for each day of the competition, including arrival and departure days. International Sambo Federation (FIAS) pays per diem allowances to a maximum of 20 referees at the rate of 50 USD for each day of the competition.

7.10 The management, officials, representatives and volunteers of the International Sambo Federation (FIAS), the European Sambo Federation (ESF) and Israel Sambo Federation (as the host organizing authority) shall NOT in anyway whatsoever be held liable to meet or contribute towards any additional expenses that may be incurred by any team member or official participating in this the European Sambo Championship 2023.

8. Awarding.

8.1 Prize-winning athletes shall be awarded with medals and diplomas.

8.2 Red SAMBO uniform is required at the official ceremonies.

8.3 During the awarding ceremony national anthem will be played along with raising a flag.
