# Regulations Youth and Juniors World Sambo Championships 2017 October 12-16, 2017 Novi Sad. Serbia

#### 1. GENERAL TERMS

- 1.1 Youth and Junior World Sambo Championships 2017 (hereinafter referred to as the World Sambo Championship) shall be held in accordance with the FIAS Regulations on Preparation and Staging of the Official Competitions (sport and organizational rules) and the International sambo Competition Rules.
- 1.2 World Sambo Championship shall be held in order to decide on the winner in corresponding age groups as well as to promote and develop sambo worldwide, and strengthen the international relations.

# 2. COMPETITIONS ORGANIZERS

2.1 General management of the organization and holding of the World Sambo Championships 2017 shall be the responsibility of the International Sambo Federation (FIAS) together with Sambo Federation of Serbia.

## 3. DATES AND VENUE

- 3.1 World Sambo Championship shall be held from 12 to 16 October 2017.

- 3.3 Accreditation will take place at the hotel "Novi Sad", Bulevar Jase Tomica bb, 21000 Novi Sad, Serbia.

### 4. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

4.1 Those athletes who are affiliated to their National Sambo Federation at the age of 17-18 (1999-2000, Youth, M&F) and 19-20 years of age (1997-1998, Juniors M&F) are able to participate at the championship.

Registration of athletes is made by means of the FIAS online license and competitions registration system <a href="http://registration.sambo-fias.org/">http://registration.sambo-fias.org/</a>. Each National Sambo Federation received an individual login and password for their accounts. Admission of athletes to the competitions is made only by means of FIAS online license and competitions registration system. The cost of license is 35 USD. All the athletes should have sports medical insurance. Athletes of 2001 year of birth in order to participate should have written permission of a doctor in English.

#### 5. TECHNICAL TERMS

- 5.1 World Sambo Championship shall be held in accordance with FIAS Sports and Organization Rules and the International Sambo Competition Rules. Refereeing of the competition shall be entrusted to the panel of referees approved by the Chairman of FIAS Referees Commission.
- 5.2 Only international category referees who were appointed by the Chairman of FIAS Referees Commission are able to referee the competition. Each referee should have a corresponding license for the current year 2017.

- 5.3 Repechage system from semi-finalists is applied what means that a competitor who loses to the pool semi-finalists drops into the repechage bracket. Team medal count is conducted according to the gold first ranking system (based first on the number of gold medals, then silver and bronze).
- 5.4 Participation in the competition is allowed only if each athlete has a medical insurance to be submitted to the Mandate Commission of competitions. Competition participants are insured at the expense of the sending organization.
- 5.5 The Organizing Committee guarantees to provide all the participants with the first aid (if necessary).
- 5.6 According to the Organising and Holding of the Official FIAS Competitions Appendix 7 (page 24) each competitor is obliged to have a backnumber comprising his last name and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation on the back of his uniforms (red & blue). The backnumber should be ordered only from the licensed supplier: Asociatia Combat Sport Equipment <a href="https://www.sambobacknumber.com">www.sambobacknumber.com</a>
- 5.7 During the accreditation, all the countries delegates should provide the Organizing Committee with a short version (not more than 30 seconds) of corresponding national anthem in electronic format (soft copy).

#### 6. ANTI-DOPING

- 6.1 Doping controls will be conducted by the National Anti-Doping Organization officially recognized by WADA. The selection of the athletes will be carried out in accordance with the FIAS Anti-Doping Rules 2015 which are based on 2015 WADA Code. The selected athletes will be accompanied by a chaperone of the Organization since the moment when receive the notice until they arrive to the doping control station. A person of the choice of the athletes (the team physician, trainer and head of delegation) can accompany them. In case of which the Organizing Committee does not provide accreditation card with photography the selected athletes is required to provide to the Doping Control Officer a valid passport or identity document with photography.
- 6.2 The teams' representatives must carefully plan their departure date and time after the competition taking into account that the athletes may be chosen for the Doping Control.

#### 7. ENTRIES

7.3 Mass media representatives will pass additional accreditation process at the official FIAS website: http://sambo-fias.org in the section Press Centre – Press Accreditation not later than September 25.

## 8. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

- 8.1 Each delegation member shall pay a fee at the amount of 85 EUR (100 USD) per day to the Organizing Committee (accommodation and meals 2 times a day). Minimum accommodation duration is two days.
- 8.2 The cost of transfer from airport or railway station to the official hotel and back and during competitions from official hotel to the competition venue and back costs **20** EUR for each team member and to be paid by the national federations.
- 8.3 In case of individual reservation of accommodation each national federation shall pay an accreditation fee at the amount 150 US dollars for each team member (accommodation, meals, transfer are not included in this fee) to the Organizing Committee to cover the cost of organizing the championships.
- 8.4 All the participants travel to the competition venue at the expense of sending organizations.
- 8.5 Heads of delegations shall settle all financial issues and meet accreditation requirements on the day of arrival. Payment to be made on site in **EUR**.
- 8.6 The Organizing Committee shall provide with accommodation and meals: FIAS President, Secretary General, Chairman of the Referees Commission, Chief Referee, Chief Secretary and 24 referees.
- 8.7 FIAS shall pay the work of the Chairman of the Referees Commission, Chief Referee and Chief Secretary at the rate 100 US dollars for each day of competitions, including the days of arrival and departure. FIAS shall pay the work of 24 referees at the rate of 50 US dollars for each day of competitions.

# 9. AWARDING

- 9.1 Prize-winning athletes shall be awarded with medals, diplomas and presents.
- 9.2 Red sambo uniform is required at the awarding ceremony.
- 9.3 During the awarding ceremony national anthem will be played along with flying a flag.
- 9.4 Prize-winning teams shall be awarded with cups and diplomas.
