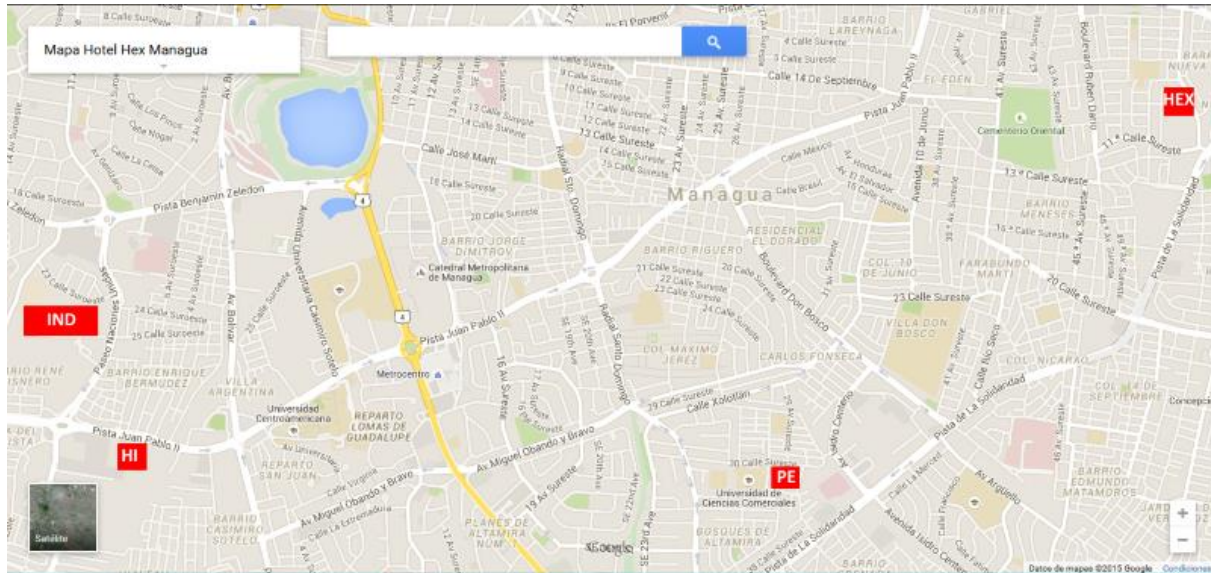

3.4 Reservation and payment

1. On the basis of the application of each delegation a requirement for payment or invoice will be sent by e-mail.
2. Upon receipt of the payment will be sent a confirmation letter with the details of the reservation made.
3. 100% of accommodation fee shall be deposited into the bank account below relating, at the latest on 10 August 2015.
4. Partial or full payments made before 1 August 2015 can be applied to a full refund at the request of the Federation depositor performed within a period not greater than 5 days from that date, the charges incurred for the return shall be borne by the applicant.
5. Payments made after the 00: 01 of August 1, 2015 shall not be subject to refund in any case.
6. At hotel check-in time is at 14:00, check-out is at 12:00
7. Extra services (mini bar, telephone calls, laundry, taxi etc.) will be charged to the room account and must be paid before leaving the hotel by the corresponding delegation.

The Organising Committee will not impose economic penalties to countries that cannot make the bank transfer, but these countries must guarantee that will make the payment in cash at the time of his arrival in Managua. However, these countries will inform exactly the number of participants and their names within the final deadlines. Charges for all transfers shall be for account of the participant delegation, as well as the surcharge which may be incurred due to lack of reservation. Reservation of extra rooms, can be done with a surcharge of 10%, no exceptions will be.

Important: Any damage caused in sports facilities or the hotel will be charged to the account of the Federation to which belong the athletes responsible for and must be paid immediately.

4. Local Transport

The Organizing Committee will ensure the movements of referees, athletes, coaches and officials during competitions. Each Member of the participating delegations will pay a single fee of USD\$ 10.00 for the transport from the Airport (bus station) to the hotel and vice versa.

5. Insurance

Each Federation National is responsible for their competitors and should assume the responsibility for the accident and health insurance, as well as civil responsibilities for competitors and officials, during the Championship.

The Organizer Committee is not responsible of any insurance related with the materials mentioned above. However, the Federation Nicaragüense de Sambo will take all the measures needed to ensure primary and/or emerging health care for every day of competition.

The Organizer Committee assumes no responsibility for any claims in cases of injury, disease or death arising out of participation or travel related to the Championship.

6. Deadlines for Application

Preliminary registration (by number):	25 July 2015

Delegations who miss the final record date will not be admitted to participate. There will be no exceptions!

All competitors, coaches and officials must register in time. After the fatal term expressed nobody may and not will be added.

Note: Only will be allowed the replacement of a member, of the delegation already registered, in case of proven injury.

7. Official Registration and Accreditation

The official registry and the expedition of accreditation cards will be held at the Hotel HEX on September 3 between 18:00 and 20:30

At least one team's official should attend in time to confirm the official record of all athletes and other officials with his signature. The non-submission of data from the delegation for official registration may give rise to the exclusion of all the participants of the sweepstakes and the event. In case of unexpected delay of the arrival of the Federation, you should communicate immediately with any of the contact persons of the Organizing Committee. Will be issued accreditation card with photography for competitors, officials and the media. This accreditation card should be with the guest at all times. Digital photographs, passport size, individual for each participant, must be attached to the list of members of each delegation.

Passports or the copy of passports of all competitors must be available in case they will be required.

8. Number of Participants

Each delegation can register a maximum of 27 athletes, one for each category of weight, gender and mode (sport or combat, in the case of males) and a maximum of 7 officers.

9. Rules of Competition

- a) Competencies will be under the latest rules and regulations approved by the FIAS, the rules of arbitration of FIAS and its Anti-Doping rules.
- b) Weight categories:

Sport sambo:

- Men: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, + 100
- Women: 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, + 80

Combat Sambo:

- Men: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, + 100

- c) Duration of matches: 5 minutes men and women 4 minutes

10. Referees

The arbitrators shall be appointed by the Arbitration Commission of the FIAS.

11. Weigh-in

- a) Weigh-in will be held in accordance with rules of the FIAS
- b) Weigh-in of athletes will be held as shown in the programme
- c) The weighing the first day will take place in the Hotel HEX

12. Draw

- a) The draw will be held at the weigh-in
- b) Each National Federation must send at least one delegate to attend the draw. Shall be allowed a maximum of three (3) delegates by National Federation (2 officers and 1 athlete).

13. Uniform and Equipment Control

- a) Uniforms: competitors must wear a uniform approved by the FIAS according to the rules and regulations for FIAS events.
- b) Equipment control: Will be done by the referees before each match.

If an athlete does not respect the rules on the uniform, the coach responsible for will be suspended by the rest of the competition day. In the case of recidivism the coach will be suspended by the rest of the competition.

13.1 Rules relating to the female athletes

The competitors must wear under the jacket, a "T" shirt white or almost white, with short sleeves, long enough to be used within the shorts, or a smooth colour suit white or almost white with short sleeves. No brand should be visible when the jacket is up. All others regulations must be respected.

14. Anti-Doping Control

Anti-Doping control will be made by the Regional Anti-Doping Organization officially recognized by WADA, and the cost of the collections of samples and analysis of samples will be covered by FIAS. The selection of the athletes will be carried out in accordance with the Anti-Doping rules of the FIAS. The selected athletes will be accompanied by a chaperone of the Organization since the moment when receive the notice until they arrive to the doping control station. A person of the choice of the athletes (the team physician, trainer, fitness coach, and head of delegation...) can accompany them. In the case of which the Organizing Committee does not provide accreditation card with photography the selected athlete is required to provide to the Control of Doping a valid passport or identity document.

15. VISA

The Organizing Committee will be happy to help any country, obtaining visas for athletes and officials. Nations that need a visa to enter to Nicaragua, in America they are very few, please send to organizing Committee as soon as possible (date August 10, 2015 top) the list of participants with names, numbers of passport, date of birth and functions within the delegation.

16. Code of Conduct

All National federations, officials, coaches and athletes participating in the Championship have to respect and accept the authority of the FIAS and its officials, the statutes, this event regulations, FIAS rules of arbitration, as well as the Anti-Doping rules of the FIAS.

17. Protocol

The competitor with the red uniform will stand behind the podium according to the following order 2 - 1 - 3 - 3. Each competitor having won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive the medal personally. If a competitor is absent during the ceremony, without a valid reason, will lose the right to receive the medal. Is strictly prohibited for competitors on the podium take national flags or any other similar identifications different of represented in their regular uniform. Any demonstration of religious, policy, personal or business type is prohibited, as well as is prohibited wear a cap or any other accessory that covers the head. The flags of each country (2) and the national anthem (CD) will be delivered to the Organizing Committee at the time of accreditation by each representative.

This is an official event supported by FIAS, only will be admitted the representations (delegations) of those countries or organizations recognized as members or candidates by FIAS. Any consultation or discussion about it is not for the Organizing Committee or the Hosting Federation, please send it to the appropriate authorities.
