1. GENERAL TERMS

1.1 The World Beach SAMBO Championships 2026 (Men & Women and Team Competition), here in after referred to as the Championship, shall be held in accordance with the FIAS Regulations for the Organization and Conduct of Official Competitions and the Beach SAMBO Competition Rules.

1.2 The Championship is organized to define the strongest athletes in corresponding age groups as well as to promote and develop SAMBO worldwide and to strengthen international relations.

2. COMPETITION ORGANIZERS

2.1 The overall organization and conduct of the Championship shall be the responsibility of the International Sambo Federation (FIAS) in conjunction with the Brazilian SAMBO Confederation.

3. DATES AND VENUE

3.1 The Championship shall be held from 11 to 14 of September 2026.

3.2 Competition venue:

Indaiá Beach, Caraguatatuba – São Paulo – Brazil.

3.3 Accreditation will take place at the hotel:

4. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

4.1 The National SAMBO Federations affiliated with FIAS have the right to take part in the Competitions. The NFS must pay the FIAS annual membership fee before the Competitions to be able to take part in the competitions. This event is open to athletes born in or before 2008 (18 years and older / turning 18 in 2008).

4.2 Weight categories:

- Men: 58 kg, 71 kg, 88 kg, +88 kg
- Women: 50 kg, 59 kg, 72 kg, +72 kg
- Mixed Team: Women 72 kg, +72 kg | Men 71 kg, 88 kg, +88 kg

*Member nations may register 1 athlete per category, who may also participate in the team event.



5. TECHNICAL TERMS

5.1 The Championship shall be held in accordance with FIAS Sports and Organizational Rules and the Beach Sambo Competition Rules. The officiating of the competition shall be entrusted to the panel of referees approved by the Charman of the FIAS Technical Commission

5.2 Only international category referees, holding a 2026 FIAS license, who were appointed by the Chairman of FIAS Technical Commission, will be able to officiate the competition.

5.3 The draw will be conducted manually and publicly after the weigh-in, with random distribution of athletes.

5.4 Individual and team competitions shall be held under a direct elimination system with repechage for finalists.

5.5 The Organizing Committee guarantees to provide all the participants with the first aid (if necessary).

5.6 All participants, coaches, referees, and representatives must have medical insurance. This insurance will be checked at the weigh-in. Athletes without health insurance will not be allowed to participate in the Championship.

5.7 Each athlete must undergo a medical examination before leaving their country for the Championship. Results of medical examinations should be recorded in the FIAS medical certificate.

5.8 Contestant uniform: Beach SAMBO jacket (white) with belt (red or blue), Beach SAMBO shorts (red or blue), and Beach SAMBO ankle support (red or blue) for men and women. Female contestants must wear a one-piece swimsuit (any color) under the jacket and shorts (without T-shirts). The Beach SAMBO jacket and belt shall be made of cotton fabric.

5.9 During the accreditation, all the countries delegates should provide the Organizing Committee with a short version (not more than 30 seconds) of corresponding national anthem in electronic format and two national flags 2X1m

6. ANTI-DOPING

6.1 All participating athletes must have completed one of the relevant Anti-Doping Education courses to receive their accreditations and participate in the Championship

For Adult and Minor Athletes:

- A NADO e-learning course (these will be accepted on a case-by-case basis, please send yours as soon as possible for consideration)
- The ITA IF Webinar Series certificate (if you participated in the ITA IF Webinar Series in 2025 or 2026 and earned a certificate, please send FIAS the copy of the certificate)

Certificates will be considered valid if completed from 1 August 2024 onwards. If an ADEL certificate was obtained prior to this date, participants must complete a refresher course and submit both their original certificate and the refresher certificate taken after 1 August 2024.



Relevant members of your team must pass the course, get the ADEL certificate and send it to FIAS until **September 6, 2026**.

If you fail to send the certificates to FIAS before September 6, beyond this date the certificates must be presented on-site before the accreditation will be handed out.

Please note that without an approved Anti-Doping Education certificate the participants will not get the accreditation for the event, therefore it is very important to pass the course and present the certificate in due time.

6.2 Doping controls shall be carried out by an Anti-Doping Organization accredited by WADA. Athletes will be selected in accordance with the requirements of the FIAS Anti-Doping Rules 2021, which are based on the 2021 WADA Code.

From the time of notification until arrival at the Doping Control Station, selected athletes will be accompanied by a chaperone trained by the Anti-Doping Organization responsible for sample collection at the event.

The selected athlete may also be accompanied by one (1) representative to assist him or her with translation. The official language to be used during the doping control procedure shall be English.

If the Organizing Committee does not provide accreditation with the athlete's photo, the selected athlete will be required to present a valid passport or other identification document at the Doping Control Station. All athletes are required to plan their departure date and time, considering they may be selected for doping control.

7. ENTRY / REGISTRATION INFORMATION

7.1 Athlete registration is exclusively conducted through the FIAS Electronic System (FIAS Database) at <https://fms.sambo.sport/registration>. Admission of the athletes to the competitions will be carried out through the Database only. All questions related to the registration in FIAS Database should be addressed to FIAS at info@sambo-fias.com or +7(495)4116137 as well as checked at the FIAS YouTube channel (FIAS Database tutorials).

7.2 National federations that fail to submit their entries by **August 11, 2026**, through the FIAS Database will be required to pay a fine of **200 USD** per each delegate not registered for the competitions.

7.3 Official delegation for the Championships shall include:

1. Team leader – 1
2. Coach – 2
3. Doctor – 1
4. Masseur – 1
5. Athletes – 8 (1 athlete per weight category only)

Total: 13

7.4 Mass media representatives will undergo an additional accreditation process at the FIAS official website, not later than August 11, 2026.

8. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS



8.1 Each member of the official delegation should pay:

Double Room: **100 USD** per person/day, including breakfast and dinner.

Single Room: **150 USD** per person/day, including breakfast and dinner.

8.2 Any members of each delegation that will NOT stay at the official hotels must pay the amount of **200 USD each**, and no services will be provided to them. The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any situation that occurs due to this action.

8.3 Transfer cost from/to the airport to/from hotel and competition venue is **50 USD** per person.

8.4 The heads of delegations must resolve all financial issues with the organizing committee on the day of arrival and fulfill all the requirements for accreditation.

8.5 The Organizing Committee provides food and lodging of FIAS President, FIAS Secretary General, the Chairman of Technical Commission, Chief referee, Chief Secretary and the 15 referees in accordance with the rules of FIAS.

8.6 The cost of the FIAS license is 60 USD, which includes international sports insurance for selected FIAS competitions. These competitions are part of the FIAS international competitions list chosen for the 2026 insurance program (the terms and conditions of the Insurance are provided upon request to the NSF at info@sambofias.com; the NSF is responsible for informing athletes and officials about the Insurance Rules in advance). Each participant paying the 60 USD FIAS license fee is automatically included in the insurance program and receives medical sports insurance. According to the insurance program rules, it is not prohibited to have additional insurance, but the license price will remain 60 USD. Any other team member (officials) wishing to be included in the FIAS insurance program may do so by making the corresponding payment of 60 USD. License payment and participant insurance for the Competitions should be handled by the National SAMBO Federations whose teams participate in the Competitions.

9. VISA INFORMATION

9.1 Immigration requirements for entry into Brazil must be observed in accordance with the legislation in force at the time of the event.

9.2 The Brazilian SAMBO Confederation will provide visa support only to those delegations, which will apply through the FIAS Database.

9.3 The Organizing Committee is pleased to provide all possible assistance to the National Federations of each country in obtaining the corresponding visa to enter Brazil. The Organizing Committee will provide the necessary visa assistance upon notification before **July 31, 2026**.

10. AWARDS

10.1 Prize-winning athletes shall be awarded with medals, diplomas, and trophies for teams.



10.2 Beach SAMBO jacket (white) with a red belt, red Beach SAMBO shorts, and red Beach SAMBO ankle support for men and women are required at the official ceremonies.

10.3 During the awarding ceremony, the national anthem will be played along with the raising of a flag

10.4 The top four teams (1st, 2nd, and two 3rd places), based on the competition results, shall be awarded with cups (mixed team in Beach Sambo)
