### 3. TRANSPORTATION

### 4. FIAS LICENSE AND INSURANCE

After January 1st of 2019, the FIAS License costs 60 USD, which includes an International Sports Insurance for the selected competitions in the FIAS calendar. Each participant that paid 60 USD for the FIAS license fee will automatically receive a sports medical insurance. According to the rules of the insurance program, it is not prohibited to have other insurance, but the price of the license will remain 60 USD.

The competitor's licenses should be paid by the Nationals SAMBO Federations whose teams participate in the competitions.

The Organizing Committee does not assume any responsibility in case of any injury, illness or death that may arise during the competition or trips related to the Pan American SAMBO Championships.

### 5.2 Weight Categories

Sport SAMBO Men: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg
 Sport SAMBO Women: 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, +80 kg

Combat SAMBO: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg

Beach SAMBO by Team: Team of five (5) athletes; three (3) males (74, 90, +90 kg) and two

### 5.3 Number of Athletes and Team Officials of the delegation

### 5.3.1 Number of Athletes

Each National Federation can enroll only one athlete per weight category in the event. An athlete can participate in more than one discipline, but always in the same weight category and according to the FIAS Rules. According to the disciplines and weight categories the delegation could be composed as follows:

Sport SAMBO Men: nine (9) athletes

Sport SAMBO Women: nine (9) athletes

Combat SAMBO: nine (9) athletes

Beach SAMBO Men: four (4) athletes

Beach SAMBO Women: four (4) athletes

Beach SAMBO by Team: five (5) athletes

The total number of athletes for one delegation is forty (40), in case there is one athlete for each discipline; twenty-five (25) men and fifteen (15) women.

### 5.3.2 Number of Team Officials

Also, the delegation of each National Federation may accredit team officials as follows:

Delegates: 2Coaches: 4Referees: 4Doctors: 2

In total the National Federation of each country will be able to officially accredit 52 participants in the delegation according to the previously specified.

### 6. ACCREDITATION AND OFFICIAL REGISTRATION

The accreditation will be held at the host hotel of the event. From the 26th to the 27th of June 2019 a space will be set up for the Official Registration and Accreditation. A team official of each National Federation shall be attentive and come on time to complete the enrollment, because it is a mandatory process. During this accreditation and registration process the corresponding revisions of information of each participant and their role in the event will be made. A person, who is not been duly accredited, will not be able to participate in the event.

An Accreditation Card will be issued and will contain the holder's information, its function and its photo. This accreditation card shall be carried all the time by the holder, except during the time when an athlete is competing.

Heads of National Teams participating in the Competition shall submit documents confirming the payment of the FIAS annual membership fee by the National Federations (receipt of payment or bank transfer slip) during the accreditation to the FIAS Treasurer or an authorized representative.

Heads of delegations shall also provide the following documents: copy of the entry form, passport or other identification document.

### 7. WEIGH-IN

The weigh-in will be held according to the current Regulations of the International SAMBO Federation (FIAS). One athlete can compete only in one weight category, which corresponds to its actual weight and which is displayed on the official scale. Time and place of the weigh-in is indicated in the program.

There will be scales for athletes to control their weight at the host hotel and at the competition venue.

#### IMPORTANT:

Athletes that compete in the Sport SAMBO or Combat SAMBO and then compete in the Beach SAMBO will not have the special weigh-in for the Beach SAMBO Championships and the registration will be based on the previous weigh-in for the Sport SAMBO / Combat SAMBO.

Athletes that compete only in Beach SAMBO will have the weigh-in on June 29<sup>th</sup> at the venue (13:30-14:00).

### 8. UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT CONTROL

All competitors shall wear uniforms and equipment approved by the International SAMBO Federation (FIAS). At all times athletes shall comply with the Regulations for Organizing and Holding Official FIAS Competitions and FIAS Rules. Before each bout, the corresponding review and control will be done by the referees and technicians designated for that purpose. Failure to comply with the rules and regulations pertaining to the control of uniforms and equipment entails penalties for the coach or athlete in the event.

According to the Regulations for Organizing and Holding Official FIAS Competitions (Annex 7), all participants of the official FIAS competitions must wear a patch (back number) on the back of their SAMBO jackets (red and blue) indicating their name as well as the national code (IOC national codes).

Athletes who do not have a back number on their SAMBO jackets will not be allowed to compete.

### 9. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The doping controls are carried out by the WADA recognised Anti-Doping Organization. The whole procedure of doping control starting from athlete selection and finishing by sample analysis is fully compliant to the FIAS 2015 Anti-Doping Rules and 2015 WADA Code.

After receipt of a notification until arrival at the point of doping control the selected athlete will be accompanied by the official representative of the Anti-Doping Organisation. One representative belonging to athletes' delegation should accompany the athlete at doping control station. The selected athlete is required to provide a valid passport or identity document at the point of doping control.

All athletes shall plan their departure from the competition with consideration that any athlete may be selected for doping control.

Nine (9) referees for the event will be appointed by the FIAS Technical Commission in accordance with the current procedure and regulations. Other referees must be authorized by their National SAMBO Federations.
