REGULATIONS

FIAS WORLD SAMBO CHAMPIONSHIP

AMONG MEN, WOMEN AND COMBAT SAMBO

November 12-16, 2015

1. COMPETITIONS MANAGEMENT

General management of the organization and holding of the 2015 World SAMBO Championship (hereinafter Championship) is performed by International SAMBO Federation (FIAS) jointly with Royal Moroccan Federation of SAMBO and TAI JITSU, under aegis the Ministry of Youth and Sports.

2. DATES AND VENUE

The World Championship is held in the period from November 12 to 16, 2015 in Casablanca (Morocco) Mohamed V Complex. Address: Complexe Sportif Mohamed V, Casablanca, Morocco.

The accreditation of participants will take place in Suisse Hotel (Bd De La Corniche Ain Diab, Casablanca)

The weigh-in of the competitors of day 1 of the competitions will take place in **Suisse Hotel** (Bd De La Corniche Ain Diab, Casablanca)

The weigh-in of the competitors of 2nd and 3rd days will take place in the **Sports Complex** (Complexe Sportif Mohamed V, Casablanca, Morocco).

3. PARTICIPATION TERMS

The right to compete is granted only to those athletes who meet the below mentioned requirements:

Athletes with FIAS license book with a 2015 FIAS annual license fee payment note in it.

- Athletes who come to participate in the Championship, but who have failed to pay the license on time, should pay an annual license fee (\$25) on-site while passing the accreditation. Athletes, who do not have license book, can buy it from the treasurer of the person authorized by him. An athlete's photo and 10 US dollars are required to obtain a license book.
- Athletes are required to have a medical health insurance.

4. APPLICATION FOR PARTICIPATION

<u>By 15th September</u>, 2015 National SAMBO Federations should send to the Organizing Committee e-mail address: <u>frmstj@gmail.com</u> (also putting in the copy the FIAS address <u>info@sambo-fias.com</u>) the completed Registration forms with signature and stamp of Federation:

- Annex No.1 Preliminary application;
- Annex No.2 Application for visa processing, information on arrival and departure.
- Annex No.3 Accreditation form (should be completed for EACH member of delegation and sent with passport copy and photo in good resolution of **300 dpi** minimum).

Please note that the incomplete Registration forms WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

The number of the members of the delegation from the NSF at the World SAMBO Championship 2015:

In case of any changes of the delegation, <u>by 27th September, 2015</u> the Federations should send their final applications to the Organizing Committee to confirm the number of members of their delegation.

Please note that after the 27th September, 2015 any changes or modifications of the number of participants indicated in the final applications will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

At the accreditation the National Sambo Federations will pay for the accommodation, meals and transfers for the number of people in accordance with their final application sent before the 27thSeptember, 2015.

In case if there are any other participants not indicated in the final application in time, the accreditation fee equal to 150 USD per person must be paid to the Organizing Committee. In the mean time the Organizing Committee does not guarantee the possibility of accommodation and transfer of such participants.

5. TECHNICAL TERMS

The competitions are held in accordance with the International SAMBO Federation (FIAS) Spot Organization Rules.

Weight categories:

Men: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg;

• Women: 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, + 80 kg;

• Combat SAMBO: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg.

The Organizing Committee guarantees first aid assistance to all Championship participants (if required).

Individual championship is held according to direct elimination system with double repechage. Athletes-winners will be awarded with medals and diplomas.

Team medal count is conducted according to the Olympic principle (by number of gold, silver and bronze medals). Team winners will be awarded with cups.

Only international referees appointed by the Chairman of FIAS Referee Commission and having the FIAS license for 2015, are allowed to officiate at the Championship.

6. DOPING TESTS

The Anti-Doping control will be made by official Regional Anti-Doping Organization recognized by WADA, and the cost of the sample collections and sample analyses will be covered by FIAS.

The selection of the athletes will be carried out in accordance with the FIAS Anti-Doping Rules. Selected athletes will be constantly accompanied by an official chaperone from the organization from the time they receive their notice until they reach the Doping Control Station. A person of their choice (their respective representative in accordance with FIAS Anti-Doping Rules 2015) may accompany them.

In case of the Organizing Committee will not provide the accreditation card with the photographs, selected athlete is obliged to provide at the Doping Control Station a valid passport or ID card.

7. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

Each participant of the Championship shall fulfill the financial obligations to the Organizing Committee upon arrival in Casablanca.

Contribution rate for accommodation and meals (Breakfast and Dinner) is 100 USD per 1 day per person. The hotel will be provided for participants.

The cost of back-to-back transfer from the airport to the official hotel of the Championship and transfer in competitionsis 20 USD per person.

In case of independent accommodation in the hotel other than selected by the Organizing Committee, each member shall pay to the Organizing Committee a fee for accreditation at the Championship equal to 150 USD per person that covers organizational expenses. Wherewithal, the payment for chack-to-back transfer from the airport to the hotel is made separately.

Organizing committee shall cover the expenses for accommodation, meals and back-to-back transfers from the airport to the hotel and transfer on competitions days for FIAS President, FIAS General Secretary.

FIAS pays the cost for accommodation and meals of the Chief Referee, Chief Secretary, assistant Chief Secretary and six referees.

National SAMBO Federations should pay the cost of accommodation and meals for their Referees, officially appointed by the FIAS for the Championship.

FIAS shall pay for the Chief Referee and Chief Secretary and Assistant Chief Secretary of the Championship work the amount of 100 USD per each day of the Championship, including arrival and departure days. Payment for 24 referees' work is made in the amount of 50 USD per each day of the event.

8. ACCREDITATION

All participants shall be accredited for the event. Accreditation will be held at the Suisse hotel. During the procedure of accrediting the teams representatives shall submit to the Organizing Committee the national flags (3 pieces) and the phonograms with the state Anthem (CD and mini-disk).

To get the accreditation, mass media representatives should first complete the appropriate form in the section "Media Center" – "Accreditation" at the FIAS official web site http://sambo-fias.org/pages/accreditation specifying in the "comments" section competition title – Sambo World Championship – 2015. The form should be completed not later than and including the 15thOctober, 2015.

9. VISA SUPPORT

All the Championship participants will be provided with visa support necessary to obtain visa in the Moroccan consular.

10. MARKETING AND ADVERTISING

The host shall use its best endeavors to guarantee the observance of FIAS Marketing Guidelines as well as sponsorship rights for FIAS partners and sponsors, covered by the relevant contracts.

11. MEDIA

The host shall use its best endeavors to guarantee to provide the relevant working conditions for accredited Media representatives during the event in compliance with FIAS Media guidelines.

12. TV AND HOST BROADCASTER

The host shall use its best endeavors to guarantee to provide the relevant working conditions for accredited TV companies and Host Broadcaster representatives during the event in compliance with FIAS TV guidelines.
