

REGULATIONS
of World SAMBO Championship among masters
October 25-28, 2014, Nea Moudania - Chalkidiki (Greece)

1. TASKS AND OBJECTIVES

1. SAMBO development and promotion in the world;
2. SAMBO promotion in Greece;
3. Consolidation of the international sports contacts.

2. COMPETITION MANAGEMENT

General management of organization and conduction of World SAMBO Championship 2014 among veterans is done by SAMBO Federation of Greece under the support of International SAMBO Federation (FIAS) and the Ministry of Culture and Sports of Greece.

3. TIME AND VENUE

World Championship will take place from October 25 to October 28, 2014 in Nea Moudania - Chalkidiki (Greece). Venue: Sports Hall of Paulou Mela Square and turn of Dimitriou Iordanidi.

18.00-19.00	Weigh-in and drawing of lots of age-group athletes: men: 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, weight category: 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg.

15.00-16.00	Weigh-in and drawing of lots of age-group athletes: men: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65 and older, weight categories: 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg.
17.30-18.00	Opening ceremony
18.00	Final matches, medal ceremony
October 27	
10.00-15.00	Start of the competitions – preliminary matches
15.00-16.00	Final matches, medal ceremony
October 28	Departure of the delegations

4. PARTICIPATION TERMS

Only athletes who comply with the requirements below are allowed to participate in the competitions:

✓ Athletes who have the FIAS license book with a corresponding stamp, confirming 2014 annual license fee.

Those athletes who arrived to participate in the Championship, but failed to pay FIAS annual license fee in due time, must pay annual license fee (25 US dollars) at accreditation. Those who do not have a license book can purchase it from authorized FIAS representative. The athletes must submit a photograph and pay 10 US dollars to obtain a license book.

Payments are made in US dollars only.

The athletes, who do not have sports health insurance, will have an opportunity to purchase the relevant insurance from Championship Organizing Committee when accrediting.

5. APPLICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

The national SAMBO Federation (or each athlete individually) must submit completed Registration Forms and a **PHOTO of each participant** to the Organizing Committee before September 25, 2014 to the following e-mail address: sambokurash@yahoo.gr

6. TECHNICAL TERMS

The competitions are held in accordance with the International SAMBO competitions rules and Regulations of the International SAMBO Federation on preparation and conduction of the international competitions.

Age groups of the participants (men): 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54,55-59, 60-64, 65 and older,

Weight categories (men): 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg.

The Organizing Committee guarantees first aid to all participants of the Championship.

Individual competitions are held according the Olympic system.

Only referees of the international category, who have FIAS license, are allowed to judge the competitions.

The athletes, who take prize-winning places, are awarded with medals and diplomas.

Teams that take prize-winning places are awarded with cups.

7. FINANCIAL TERMS

Every participant of the Championship must fulfill all the financial obligations to the Organizing Committee on the day of arrival to Nea Moudania-Chalkidiki.

The amount of the fee for accommodation and food is 100 US dollars or 75 euros (preferably in euro) for one day per person. The participants will stay at «Portes Beach» Hotel.

Transfer from the airport (or railway or bus station) of Thessaloniki city to the official hotel of the Championship and back, as well as from the hotel to the sports hall costs 20 US dollars or 15 euros (preferably in euro) per person.

In case of self accommodation at the hotel, different from the one chosen by the Organizing Committee, every participant must pay Championship accreditation fee in the amount of 150 US dollars or 110 euro for one person on account of the host party, which covers the organization expense. In such a case transfer from the airport (or railway or station) of Thessaloniki city to the hotel and back is paid on the individual basis.

The Organizing Committee covers the expenses connected with accommodation, transfer from the airport (or railway or bus station) of Thessaloniki city to the hotel and back on the days of the Championship for the following persons: FIAS President, FIAS General Secretary, Chairman of the FIAS Referee Commission, Chief Referee and Chief Secretary of the Championship.

FIAS covers payment for work of the Chairman of the Referee Commission, Chief Referee of the Championship and Chief Secretary of the Championship in the amount 100 US dollars per each day of the Championship, including the days of arrival and departure. 20 referees of the international category are paid 50 US dollars per each day of the Championship.

FIAS covers the expenses for accommodation and food of 15 referees.

8. ACCREDITATION

All participants shall be accredited. Accreditation will take place at Portes Beach Hotel, located at:

While accrediting, representatives of teams shall submit national flags (3 pcs.) and the soundtracks with the country's National Anthem (CD and MD) to the Organizing Committee

The representatives of Mass Media and those who want to be accredited, shall submit completed Individual Registration Forms to the Organizing Committee of the Championship no later than September 25, 2014 and fulfill the relevant form in Media center-Accreditation section on FIAS official web page <http://goo.gl/mJ5D62> no later than October, 24.

9. VISA SUPPORT

All participants of the Championship will receive visa support necessary to obtain visa in the consulates of Greece.

10. MARKETING AND ADVERTISEMENT

The Organizing Committee guarantees the rights of sponsorship to the FIAS partners and sponsors provided in the corresponding Agreements, including FIAS Marketing Guidelines published on FIAS official website, Documents section - <http://sambo-fias.org/pages/dokumenty>

The organizing committee makes sure throughout the event to provide the relevant working conditions for the accredited press representatives in compliance with FIAS requirements, FIAS section, Documents subsection- [http:// sambo-fias.org / pages / dokumenty](http://sambo-fias.org/pages/dokumenty).
